**Sub : KSHEC – Chancellor’s Award 2019**

## 1. Chancellor’s Award

The Kerala State Higher Education Council invites application for the prestigious Chancellor’s Award for the year 2019. The award is in two categories - **Established Universities** and the **Emerging Young University** (Universities up to 12 years of existence). The Chancellor’s award was instituted by the then Hon’ble Chancellor and Governor of Kerala Shri. Justice (Retd.) P. Sathasivam in 2014 to nurture the spirit of healthy competition among the State Universities in Kerala, in becoming vibrant centers of learning. The award carries an amount of Rs. 5 crores / Rs. 1 Crore, a citation and a gold plated trophy. The prize money, provided by the State Government in its Budget, is meant for capital expenditure for any major project in the University.

## 2. Methodology

The award is based on parameters like Academics, Teaching and Pedagogy Methods, Student profile and Achievements, Academic Governance, Social Inclusiveness and other Achievements. Marks are awarded based on the performance of the universities on the above criteria for the preceding year 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2018 - 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2019.

## 3. Selection Process

This year, the KSHEC has developed portal based, online facilities to upload the required data pertaining to various criteria. The uploaded data along with the supporting documents will be verified by a committee. A team would visit the universities to verify the details and prepare the final list for the award.

## 4. Mandatory requirement

Every University has to register in the KSHEC portal, and on approval of the registration process, a username and password will be issued. It is mandatory for all the Universities to submit the data in the All Kerala Higher Education Survey portal of the Kerala State Higher Education Council for the period of assessment before uploading the data pertaining to the Chancellor’s Award.

## 5. The last date for submission of online application is 15-10-2019.
