All Kerala Higher Education Survey(AKHES) 2019-20

The Kerala State Higher Education Council is launching the All Kerala Higher Education Survey for the year **2019 -20**. Modeled on the All India Survey on Higher Education and named as AKHES (All Kerala Higher Education Survey) , the survey intends to collect all the data pertaining to all the higher education institutions in the State covering Government, Aided, Autonomous, Unaided colleges and the Universities.

The survey hopes to remedy a major hindrance ie non availability of authentic data on higher education, for the State Government and KSHEC in formulating policies in the higher education sector. It also aims to overcome problems pertaining to the performance based funding caused by incomplete and inaccurate data in the higher education sector.

A dedicated portal on the website of Kerala State Higher Education Council is now open to all the stakeholders for the purpose. Data is being collected on several parameters such as Institution's Basic Details; Details of faculty; Details of Non-Teaching Staff; Programmes conducted under various Faculties/Schools & Departments/Centres; Students' enrolment in these Programmes; Examination result of terminal year of each Programme; Financial Information such as Receipt and Expenditure under various heads-Funds, Scholarships, Loans; Availability of Infrastructure etc. The portal can be accessed at www.kshec.kerala.gov.in. and the data sought is for the academic year 2019-2020 as on November 30, 2019.

Those who had participated in the previous year's survey will have the benefit of the carry-over of much of the data viz-Details of Faculty, Programmes offered etc. into this year's survey. The Nodal Officer however needs to ensure the accuracy of the data and options to edit the previous year's data is provided.

For the purpose of addition of a new institution on the portal, College Nodal Officer/ University Nodal Officer are requested to register their institutions on KSHEC portal. Only after approval by the Nodal Officers at the Kerala State Higher Education Council, the institution will be allowed to enter further details. **The last date for the uploading of data of the institutions is Feb 29, 2020**

Registration and submission of data of the institutions in the State in the survey portal is mandatory for State Assessment and Accreditation Council(SAAC),Chancellor's Award(Universities only) and Kerala Institutional Ranking Framework(KIRF)as much of the data from the survey will be picked up for the assessment.

KSHEC is planning to release a statistical booklet (annually) based on the data consolidated from the HEIs who have participated in the survey. The booklet besides including data on the above parameters will also include the list of programmes offered by the institutions in the State.

We therefore look forward to your co-operation in participating in the survey
